On this date, the undersigned Edward Peruta, contacted Michael Haluch, Managing Partner of Chili's Restaurant, 2855 Main Street, Glastonbury, CT. 06033.

The undersigned inquired if Laura Smith was back from vacation and if it would be permissible to interview her regarding an incident which took place in the restaurant on June 21, 2007.

Mr. Haluch had no objection to my speaking with Laura Smith who he stated would be coming on duty at 4:00pm, and suggested that the interview be conducted after 8:00pm during a period that the restaurant was not busy with night time dinner guests.

The undersigned prepared a CD of the Glastonbury Police Department 911 audio clips recorded on June 21, 2007, together with a series of documents some of which attempt to document an incident where James F. Goldberg was arrested on the charge of Breach of Peace in the second degree.

Ms. Smith is also being provided with several documents which evidence the fact that carrying a pistol or revolver by an individual with a valid state permit to do so, can carry their weapon openly.

Ms. Smith, ( **has agreed - has not agreed** ), to be interviewed and answer a series of questions relating to the facts surrounding the arrest of James F. Goldberg on the night of June 21, 2007.
